

Toyota Land Cruiser Buyer & Parts Checklist

Series■aware checklist for FJ40, FJ60, 80, 100, 200 & 300 Series owners.

1. Identify Your Land Cruiser

- Confirm series (FJ40 / FJ60 / 80 / 100 / 200 / 300).
- Verify build year and market (US, JDM, other).
- Record VIN when available.
- Confirm axle type and ABS vs non■ABS.

2. Buyer Inspection Checklist

- Check for fluid leaks (engine, axles, transmission).
- Inspect steering play and front■end wear.
- Evaluate brakes and pedal feel.
- Inspect cooling system hoses, radiator, fan clutch.

3. Series■Specific Priority Items

- FJ40 / FJ60: brakes, steering knuckle seals, cooling hoses, rust.
- 80 Series: front axle/knuckle service, steering refresh.
- 100 Series: ball joints, control arm bushings, cooling system.
- 200 / 300 Series: brakes, suspension wear items, filters.

4. Parts Buying Guide

- OEM: sensors, electronics, seals, complex assemblies.
- Aftermarket: brakes, suspension, service items (quality brands).
- Used: discontinued parts, trim, large hard parts (inspect first).

5. Pre■Trip Checklist

- Refresh brakes and steering components.
- Confirm cooling system reliability.
- Inspect wheel bearings and axle seals.
- Carry spare belts, hoses, and fluids.
